Members of the Workforce Development Board:

In accordance with Section 107 of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (hereinafter, “the Act”), which governs Local Workforce Development Boards, the Governor must certify local workforce development boards in each local area of the State so that they may carry out essential functions assigned to them under the Act. To that end, each Local Workforce Development Board, referenced below, is hereby certified as required by the Act. Additionally, in accordance with West Virginia Workforce Development Policy 200-02, each region’s voting preferences are listed in the table below.
